



## **Rules for Palmetto Trail through the Greenville Watersheds**

1. Trail is to be used exclusively for recreational foot traffic.
2. Trail hours are from sunrise to sunset seven days per week.
3. Hikers must be off the trail by sunset.
4. Overnight camping is prohibited.
5. Trail may be closed at any time at Water System discretion due to inclement weather or because of local or national security alerts and conditions.
6. Access to trail is only at designated trailheads.
7. Each trail user must sign in at the trailhead and sign out at trails end.
8. No signs shall be posted.
9. Littering is not allowed.
10. Body waste must be bagged and removed. Burial is not allowed.
11. Hikers must stay on the trail at all times. No shortcuts from one section of the trail to another are allowed.
12. Trail users must not cut, remove or otherwise disturb fauna/flora whether living or dead.
13. No animals may be brought onto the trail, including horses, dogs or other pets.
14. No bicycles, tricycles or motorized vehicles of any kind may be brought onto or used on the trail.
15. Hunting and fishing are strictly prohibited.
16. No incendiary devices such as matches, road flares, combustible fuels or fireworks are allowed.
17. Campfires are not allowed.
18. All hikers must be equipped with a loud sounding whistle.
19. Firearms, BB and pellet guns are strictly prohibited.
20. For safety reasons, hikers will not be permitted to hike alone.
21. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
